#### **Local Walks and attractions:**

We have maps in the shop showing the off-road route into Little Budworth. This walk is approx. 30 mins, taking you to Oulton Park Racing Circuit, Little Budworth Country park, **The Egerton Arms** (our favourite pub) with great real ales, home cooked food & real fire, very dog friendly! (01829 760424) and The Red Lion. To get there by road,

simply turn left out of the site,  $1^{st}$  right and follow Park Road for  $1\frac{1}{4}$  miles (please note Park Road is very narrow in parts).

The Whitegate way is a popular disused railway track, from Winsford to Delamere. A lovely café is situated at the entrance. Just turn left out of the site, 1st left, follow Clay Lane for 1 mile and the route & café are signposted.

The Shrewsbury Arms Pub, just 400 yards from site (turn right), serves pub style food all day every day. Friday & Saturday 12 -9pm, Sunday -Thursday 12 -8pm. Booking often not needed (01829 760240).

Tarporley Village (5 miles) is lively with boutique style cafés, clothing & gift shops, pubs, bars and restaurants. Turn right out of the site, left at the lights and follow the signs for Village centre.

## **Booking Terms & Conditions**

By staying on, visiting or using Elm Cottage Touring Pake premises you are agreeing to the following conditions. These are designed to help ensure your stay and that of others around you is a pleasant one:

- To treat other guests, the site and its equipment with respect and consideration.
- No noise between the hours of 11pm and 8.30 am.
- BBQ's are allowed as long as they are off the ground and supervised at all times.
- Max 2 adult visitors (nominal fee applies) per pitch, departing by 10pm.
- No ball games within the Touring Park, please use open areas within the Camping Field.
- Children must be supervised on the play park & only use it from 9am-dusk
- Do not let your children play around the seasonal pitches.

- All bikes or scooters to be ridden at walking pace.
- Ensure that children do not use the park after dusk & not before 8am
- NO kite flying or drones anywhere on site due to the overhead power cables.
- Please accompany your children when visiting the owl garden.
- Please keep your dog on a lead within the boundaries of your own pitch except when being exercised on the dog walk, (as long as you have control over them).
- Any dog mess to be cleared up immediately and placed in the dog -waste bins provided. This includes the grass verges along the main road.
- Keep bottles, cans, newspapers and cardboard separate from other waste and place them in the recycling bins.
- Always use a waste water container and dispose ait a notific arrived the site.
- No files (including File Light, Chinese lanterns of file works.

- Observe the 5mph speed limit on site.
- Ensure all guests/visitors report to reception on arrival.
- All extra vehicles park on the visitor's car park.
