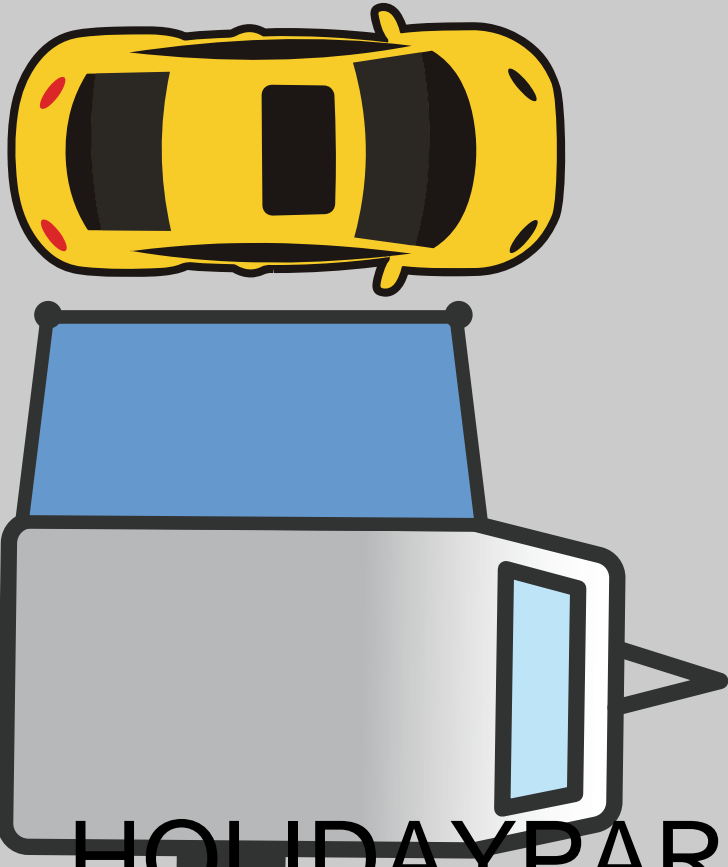

Arrival/Pitching Up

Please pitch caravan on plot as displayed.
Grey waste/Drinking water points can be found on pitch.

Elson chemical waste point is at back of buildings near the toilet block.

Barrier/Toilet Key

The key fob is used for both barriers and accessing the toilet/shower block. For barriers please show the fob to black pad on top of blue post located approx 5 metres from barrier arm on right side. For toilet block please show to black pad located on left of toilet door, to exit toilets please press the door release (white switch) located to right of door.

Departure

At time of departure from the site please place fob in post box at the exit of site. Thank you.

Welcome to Goodwin Park

Reception - Open Daily 10AM - 4PM

For general enquiries, washer/dryer tokens (powder provided), calor gas exchanges etc. We also have a small amount of caravan supplies. When the reception is closed the emergency telephone number is displayed on the reception door.

Toilets - Closed for cleaning between 10:30AM - 12 Noon daily (Sorry for any inconvenience)

The toilet block is accessed with your key fob. Please do not allow your children to come to the toilet block on their own. Please leave the toilets/showers as you would like to find them.

Laundry/pot Washing Facilities

Washer/dryer tokens are available at the reception. Wash power is provided with your wash token, please do not use any other powder (powder and softener must be non bio).

Site Rules

1. Keep your speed to a maximum of 5MPH. If you are not in 1st gear you are driving too fast. This includes bicycles. Please ensure your children adhere to this rule.
2. No visitors cars on site. Strictly one car per pitch. For alternative parking please enquire at reception within opening hours. The key fob is registered to you personally and is for your access only to the toilet block and barriers.
3. All non residents wishing to visit must be reported to the reception before arrival. Visitors to the site are the responsibility of the caravan owner. Please ensure that visitors behave in an orderly manner and do not disrupt other residents. We do not accept commercial vehicles on site.
4. Consider other residents at all times. Noise levels must be kept to a minimum, especially after 11pm.
5. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times on site. Dogs must be exercised off site. Any accidental fouling is to be cleaned up and placed in the dog poo bins provided.
6. All rubbish should be in a plastic bag and placed in the bins around the site. Strictly no electrical appliances, awnings, carpets or furniture to be put in the bin. Please take it home and dispose of at your local recycling centre. If in doubt please ask at the reception.
7. Breathable ground sheets only for awning, only one annexe per pitch.
8. Do not leave heaters on, unattended in your awning. This is a fire hazard.
9. No disposable barbecues, barbecues must be at least 18" from the ground and away from planting.
10. Sorry no ball games or kites are allowed on site.
