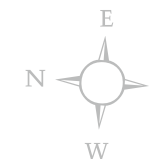

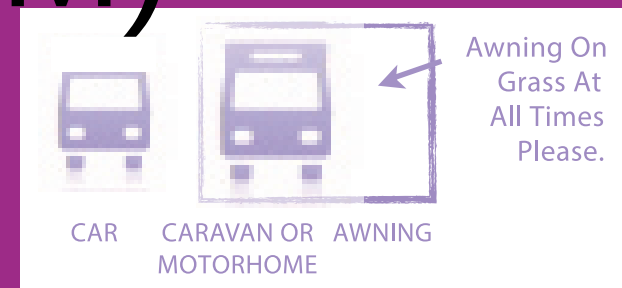


Park Plan & Guidelines

Lynn & Iain Brown and all our staff welcome you to Invercoe, we hope you enjoy your holiday here.

1. On arrival – we operate a relaxed system here at Invercoe and would ask you on arrival to choose your own pitch. Most of the park has numbered markers & these markers must be at the centre front of your caravan, motor home or tent.
2. Bookings – if you have booked a pitch, there will be one reserved for you, please enquire as to which one it is.
3. We also have a number of informal/unmarked camping areas and here you can position your tent as you choose – avoid being too near to anyone else & pitching directly in someone else's view.
4. Payment – can be made either to the shop when open or to the garden which will be on the early morning. In the winter and quieter months, please call at our house just across the main road to settle up.
5. Electric hook ups are all 10A – most can now be reset by you should you happen to overload one.
6. Ground sheets – breathable ground sheets are fine, but any other types must be lifted daily to prevent long term ground damage.
7. All pitches must be vacated by 11:00 on your day of departure, unless specific alternatives have been arranged with the owners.
8. Clothes lines are not permitted to hang from trees, fences etc close hanging drying racks or poles are fine. There is a drying room behind the gents' toilets where you can hang clothes to dry. Boots can also be left here to dry.
9. Speed limits are strictly 10mph maximum throughout the park.
10. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times including on your pitch. The foreshore terrace is still part of the park and dogs must also be kept on a lead here. Any fouling must be picked up and deposited in the relevant bins. Dogs must not be left alone in your caravan or motorhome if you are out for the day.
11. The park reception will generally be open from May till late September each year for a few hours in the morning and again in the afternoon – please check opening times at the shop. We stock most daily provisions, milk, Calor, camping gas, chemical toilet fluids, maps etc. Gas at owners house out-with shop hours.
12. Laundry – there is a laundrette behind the toilet/shower block which has three top loading washing machines (token operated – taking about 30 mins) & tumble driers (50p coin operated for 10 minutes).
13. Dish Washing Area - there are sinks for washing dishes in the room at the end of the shower block. Small items of clothing may also be hand washed here.
14. Drinking water is available from any of the water points around the park.
15. Grey water can be disposed of at the correct side of the drinking water points.
16. Motor Vehicle Waste Disposal Point – this is located at the far corner of the park and can be used for chemical toilet disposal/ grey water disposal & filling up with clean drinking water. This facility is not to be used for car or vehicle washing.
17. Chemical Toilets can be emptied only at the disposal point at the west end of the toilet block or at the Motor Vehicle Waste Disposal point at the far corner of the park.
18. Slipway – this slipway is for Invercoe guests use only – please do not obstruct the slipway by leaving your vehicle here whilst you are away for the day.
19. Recycling – glass, paper, plastic and drinks can recycling is available at the end of the shower block, please use it.
20. Barbecues are allowed but disposable BBQ's must be placed on a suitable stand or, more preferably on one of the lightweight concrete blocks available round the park.
21. Campfires are not permitted within the park boundaries.
22. Noise – please keep noise levels to a minimum at all times and respect everyone's right to complete peace & quiet from 11.00 pm till 8.00 am.
23. Security – the park is covered by 24 hour recorded CCTV, but if you do see anything suspicious, please let us know.
