

**Welcome to Ladycross**, we are delighted you have chosen to spend your holiday at our site and although we cannot guarantee good weather we will try and make your stay a happy and enjoyable one! This guide contains information on the site to help you enjoy your stay and we are always available to help so please just ask.

# Shop and reception

The shop provides a selection of local produce, basic essentials, drinks, ice creams, Calor gas and fresh free range eggs from our own Ladycross hens. We also have a variety of brochures for local attractions and a book swap library. Opening times are displayed on the shop door and if you need assistance out of hours please refer to information on the office door.

### **Arrivals**

Pitches are available from 2.00pm on the day of your arrival. Please check in at reception on arrival where we will confirm your booking, provide you information on your stay, and issue a barrier security fob (deposit required).

## **Departures**

We ask you to valate your pien by 2 mon on your ray of sleparts at Please return you have in for to office and collect our deposit Or you exit we will open the barrier for you. If you wish to extend your stay please ask at the office as this may be a possibility and there is a charge.

## Late arrivals

If you arrive after office hours the location of who to contact will be played on the door at reception.

## **Barrier**

The barrier is opened for entry and exit with your fob, ple se scan every time and do not follow other vehicles through as the anti-pass back may not allow you in or out.

# Dogs

Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead at all times including walking in the forest areas. Please be courteous and always clean up after your dog using the bins provided. Dogs must not be left unattended for any length of time in or outside caravans or awnings and excessive dog barking is not acceptable. We now have a communal open field at the bottom of the park that dogs can be exercised on, this is a shared space with children playing and dogs MUST BE CLEANED UP AFTER.

#### Fire

We are in a high fire risk area please be extra careful as fire can spread very quickly. If you notice a fire please notify the office or a warden immediately. Extinguishers are at each service point, by the amenity blocks and at reception. Fire beaters can be found at reception. Fireworks, fire crackers and fire lanterns are STRICTLY FORBIDDEN anywhere on the site.

## Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in any building on the site or in the wooded areas, however if you wish to smoke outside these areas PLEASE take care when disposing of matches or cigarette ends especially in dry hot weather.

## **Barbeques**

Due to the danger of fire within our forest setting, OPEN FIRES ARE NOT PERMITTED. Barbeques may be lit for cooking purposes only and must be positioned at the front of the caravan away from the trees and raised off the ground. In times of very dry weather when the fire risk is high, the use of barbeques may be restricted.

DISPOSABLE BBQ'S ARE PROHIBITED.

## **Speed Limit**

The speed limit on site is 5 mph. As there are often young children playing and wildlife about please take special care whilst driving around the site. For the safety of everyone, a <u>one way system</u> operates and we ask that you observe the directional signs.

## **Visitors**

If you are expecting any visitors please be reminded that they must pay at reception and park in the visitor's car park. The responsibility of letting the visitors out through the barrier belongs to the caravan being visited.

## Children

Children must be supervised at all times and extra care taken if they play in the woods. For the comfort and safety of everyone we do not allow ball games on site and children must not play in and around the toilet block. We now have a communal open field at the bottom of the park families can use to play and for ball games

### **Ponds**

We do have one small pond on the immediate site, and a larger pond in the woodland, children must be supervised at all times in these areas, lifebuoys are provided and there is STRICTLY NO SWIMMING.

## **Amenity blocks**

There are two separate amenity blocks on the site both have washing facilities, kitchen prep and chemical waste points. The blocks are cleaned daily, cleaning schedules are show on the entrance doors.

### Showers

All the showers are fitted with Hygienic Infra Red 'no touch' sensors which can be started by waving your hand in front of the sensor which will provide 60 seconds of water at a preset temperature. Simply repeat the process for more water. Please leave all the facilities clean after use.
