The Park Facilities:

All of our spacious pitches have access to 16amp electric (paid for via metre at additional cost), water and drainage. The showers are 20p/5 minutes (20p = 5minutes, 40p = 10 min etc.). Please see reception if you need 20 pences.

We offer hot/cold beverages and ice creams at reception, including ice cream for your dog. There are activities for all ages, including outdoor chess, draughts, table tennis, giant jenga and fishing*.

There is also over 350 acres of farm** and countryside surrounding the Park, and we welcome you to enjoy the space. Take a football, rounders set or a cricket bat, along with picnic and go for a walk or off-road family bike ride and make a day of it! Maps available at reception or local Public Rights of Way.

Housekeeping Rules

During your stay, we kindly request that you adhere to a few "house keeping" rules, for the safety of all, and to ensure that everyone enjoys their experience of the Park.

- Please ensure you dispose of all waste appropriately by tying bags and placing them in the correct bins in the designated areas.
- All dogs must remain on a lead whilst within the Park, but there are plenty of fields easily accessible outside of the Park where they can run freely.
- Please do not park vehicles on the grass (unless camping on a grass pitch), and no more than two cars to one hard standing pitch - please park additional cars within the car parks.
- Please use the hand sanitisers which are provided around site before entering any building.
- All children must be accompanied by an adult when using toilets and showers.
- All vehicle users must keep to the 5mph speed restriction within the park for the safety of others.
- Please keep all noise levels to a minimum between 22:00 and 09:00. Loud or unruly behaviour will not be tolerated.
- When using the alternative entranceway between 20:00 and 08:00, please ensure you close the gate after you enter/exit.
- Please familiarise with the Fire Meeting Points around the Park.

A full set of rules can be viewed in Oak Wood. The management at Peachley reserve the right to remove any person(s) deemed to be acting in a manner not befitting to the standards we strive to maintain for our Park.
