Welcome to Shallow Grange Farm

Please take a few minutes to read the following information to ensure that you and your fellow campers have an enjoyable stay.

Please do:- Recycle all rubbish in the bins provided (This is a condition of your stay.)

Keep to the public footpath across the farm.

Watch out for machinery, electric fences, gates(which should be left as found), cattle grids & other farm obstacles.

As parents, please supervise your children at all times. Please make sure they do not go into the private areas or unaccompanied to the pond.

Keep dogs on leads at all times & clean up after them.

Keep barbecues off the grass & picnic tables.

Keep off the wrapped bales. They are extremely heavy & can cause serious injury. Damage to the wrapping renders the feed useless.

Respect the privacy of the private caravan park & keep out of the private areas (see map).

Vacate your pitch by 11.00am on your last day.

Come to reception if you would like to fish or borrow a walking map.

Please do not:- Make noise after 10pm

Play music at any time.

Drive to the shower block.

Take cars onto the camping field in wet conditions except to pitch & unpitch.

Climb or remove stone from walls.

Please note: Reception is open from 9.00am to 8.00pm during holiday season & 9.00am to 6.00pm in low season, as shown. Closed for lunch 12.00 to 1.00pm

Our 850sqm, 12 peg Fishing Pond.



Our shower block offers:-

- Hot water heated by solar panels on the roof, saving lots of Co2 emissions every year

- Low energy LED lighting, making savings of up to 90% of running costs.

- Low flush toilets (less than half the water of a standard loo)

- Under floor heating, using stored solar energy

- A heat recovery ventilation system, re-using 70% of waste heat

- A high efficiency boiler system as a backup

- Dyson air blade dryers

- Rain water harvesting system to flush the toilets.

We have 60kw of PV solar panels which will supply you with green electricity for on site use.

We hope you'll be able to enjoy these facilities as part of an environmentally guilt-free holiday!



Our site has lovely views across the Derbyshire Dales and we are within easy reach of many great walks, some straight off the farm.

We have a flat, well drained field for tourers and tents. Electrical hookups, supplied with renewable energy, are available and it is advisable to book these in advance.

There is also a field for Tents not requiring hook-ups.

We have free WIFI.

We have 2 EV charging points which use 100% renewable electricity for visitors with electric vehicles.

BBQ's are allowed as long as they are raised above the grass. We also have fire baskets for hire & bags of wood for sale, sourced from the farm.

There is a freezer available for freezer blocks, washing-up & laundry facilities & disabled facilities

We are predominantly a working farm, so if you are expecting a site with a bar, a games room, a shop, a children's playground, and a swimming pool, then this is probably not the place for you.

Large rowdy groups, stag and hen parties and noisy drinking sessions are not welcome at Shallow Grange.

We do not allow music to be played on the site & expect quiet after 10pm.

Whilst families are welcome, we must point out that we do not have any entertainment facilities for children on site, and therefore expect parents to keep their children under control at all times

Dogs (1 per pitch please) are welcome on site - provided their owners are well trained! They must be on leads at all times and please be aware that there is nowhere on the farm that they can run free

In order to maintain the site in a safe and good condition, we may ask you to park your car separately and away from tents and pitches when the ground is wet.

We are committed to environmentally sensitive farming & are part of Natural England's Environmental Stewardship Scheme which encourages biodiversity so there is an expectation on everyone visiting the farm to behave respectfully towards the local environment.
